

DATA PRIVACY REGULATION DAY*

Paris January 17, 2017**

(10 AM - 5 PM)

On May 2016, the EU Regulation 'on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data' entered into force and must be transposed into the national law of all EU Member States by May 25, 2018. As stated by the European Commission, 'The objective of this new set of rules is to give citizens back control over of their personal data, and to simplify the regulatory environment for business...The reform will allow European citizens and businesses to fully benefit from the digital economy'. What is really behind this new legal instrument, how it will impact the development of innovation in Europe, how citizens/patients will benefit of it: these are the questions still open.

This one-day workshop organized by the ELSI-LE group of the Europe sponsored Knowledge & Innovation Communities (KIC) EIT-Health will try to shed some light on the consequences of the Regulation implementation. Speakers from European bodies, research institutes, companies, patient organizations and other KICs will present the Regulation and illustrate its impact with practical examples.
